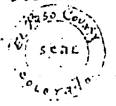
In accordance with the provisions of an Act passed by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado, Session of 1885, entitled An Act To Amend Section 4 of Chapter 95 of the General Statutes of the State of Colorado, entitled Roads and Highways, the same being Section 5834 Statutes of 1908, it was ordered by the Board that all section lines, township lines, and range lines on the public domain in El Paso County be, and the same are

hereby, declared public highways of the width of 60 feet, being 30 feet on each side of said section lines, township lines and range lines, as the case may be, the same being in El Paso County, Colorado; provided, however, that the board may, from time to time, as occasion arises, by resolution declare it necessary to develop and improve said highways when in their judgment it shall be necessary and expedient.

The above and foregoing resolution was adopted this 20th day of June 1917 by

unanimous vote of said Board.
